
The NHS Spine

Built in-house by NHS Digital **in partnership** with cutting-edge Small Medium Enterprises (SMEs)

Went live in 2014 with safe transfer of **40 terabytes of data** and **5 minutes** planned down-time.

Comprises two main systems...

- Spine Core: safely supports information-flow and national digital services
- Care Identity Service (CIS): manages secure access




The NHS Spine

Compared predecessor system the Spine..

- saves the NHS £21 million annually in running costs
- recoups the equivalent of 750 manhours per day
- has cut response times by 90 per cent.

100% availability 24/7 for more than two years










New capability supports:
