What are the financial consequences ?

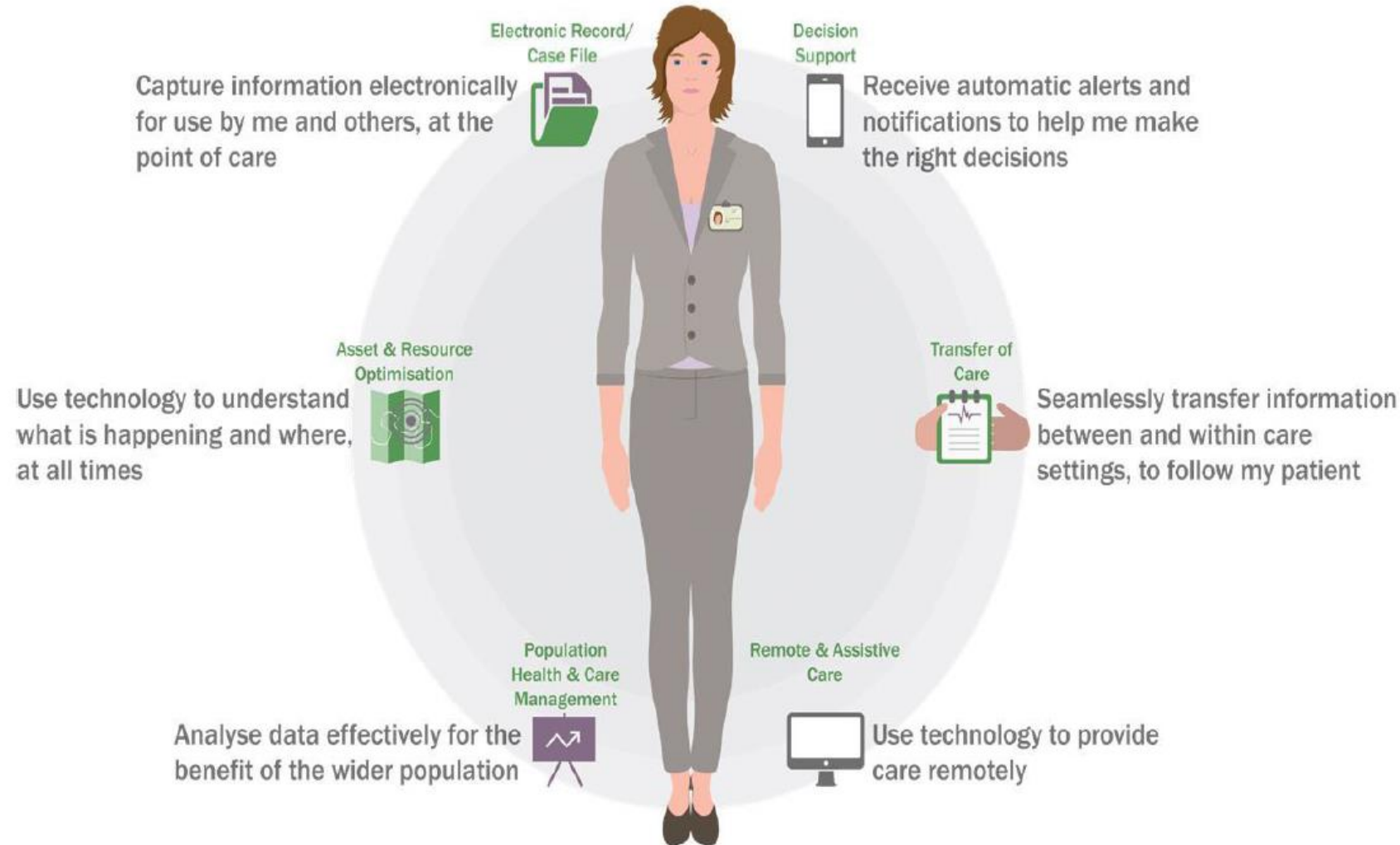
Time loss has definitively high financial consequences that could be easily avoided.

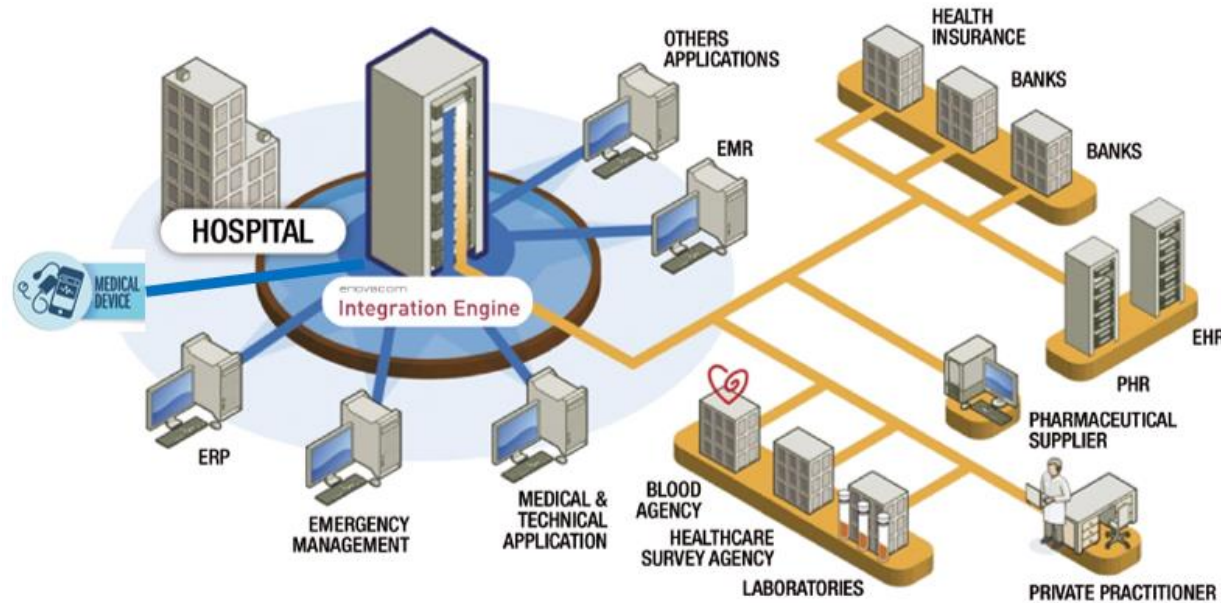
